To whom it may concern:

General Cable is committed to operating its business and facilities in a way that reduces their impact on the environment. We have comprehensive recycling and conservation plans in place to reduce, reuse and recycle the materials we use to manufacture and deliver our wire and cable products. Additionally, General Cable is a member of the U.S. Green Builders Council, as well as the Green Suppliers Network.

Our STABILOY[®] Brand aluminum building wire products, which are manufactured in our Sedalia, MO facility are RoHS compliant and have been heavy metals free containing less than 300 PPM lead since early 1990. There are also no PCBs or asbestos used in the manufacture of General Cable's building wire products.

Our Sedalia manufacturing facility has also taken great strides to reduce its environmental footprint. It is CESQG certified "Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator" of Hazardous waste, meaning we have less than 200 pounds on site at any time. It is a zero discharge facility; all process water is 100% recycled and all waste water is 100% land applied. At the same time the plant has reduced its water consumption in 2013 by 40%, or 5 million gallons. It also recycles its PVC bleed-out and reuses it at approximately 2%. Additionally, all aluminum scrap that is produced at the plant is recycled.
